Prof. Dr. Pierre-Marie Glauser February 2021



Pierre-Marie Glauser is a professor of tax law at the Faculty of Business and Economics of the University of Lausanne. He is also a partner in OBERSON ABELS, a law firm specializing in tax and commercial law.

His fields of expertise, both academically and professionally, are corporate taxation in the areas of mergers and acquisitions, financing, financial reorganizations, general taxation of companies and their shareholders, as well as value added taxes (VAT). In addition, he is a consultant for numerous scientific, cultural and sports associations and foundations, especially in VAT matters.

His research in the areas of value added taxes and corporate taxation has led to numerous publications in academic journals, and has earned him various scientific distinctions, including the 2006 Latsis Award of the University of Geneva.

He is a permanent member of the VAT advisory body of the Federal Tax Administration, appointed by the Federal Council. This extra-parliamentary committee issues opinions and recommendations regarding VAT practice. In this body, Prof. Glauser has represented the academic institutions for many years. He has also actively participated in the drafting of the current Swiss VAT law.

In 2016, he joined the Foundation Council of the ISREC Foundation. He is the president of this board since February 1, 2021.

Pierre-Marie Glauser holds a doctorate in tax law from the University of Geneva, as well as a Master's degree in law (lic. iur. HSG) and in economics (lic. oec HSG) from the University of St. Gallen. He is also a certified fiscal expert and a licensed attorney.
